- (a) That it appears upon the face of the Complaint that several causes of action have been united in one action contrary to the Statutes of the State of Wisconsin in such case made and provided.
- (b) That it also appears from the face of the Complaint that the plaintiffs ask for a considerable amount of relief which is not provided by law.
- (c) It appears from the Complaint that this action is founded upon a Land Contract for the sale of certain real estate in the City of Watertown, Jefferson County, Wisconsin.
- (d) It also appears from the face of the Complaint that the plaintiffs are electing to petition the Court for all of the remedies available under the Land Contract law of this state many of which are inconsistent remedies.
